
Tropical Depression Four



OVERVIEW

Tropical Depression Four currently near Cuba is forecast to move to the northwest and become a Tropical Storm later today near Florida. Regardless of storm strength or final track, we will likely see impacts in eastern NC as it lifts along the Southeast coast.



- As early as Tuesday night or Wednesday, and potentially for a few days.
- Long duration possible Impacts may last several days depending on the final track and whether or not this storm slows down or stalls.
 - Potential impacts include: Heavy rain, flooding, and dangerous rip currents.

• Additional hazards are possible but too far out for specifics just yet.

Remember that a tropical system of any magnitude can cause flooding.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION Most tropical related deaths are water related (flood, rip currents, storm surge, etc).

Impacts can also occur well away from the center of the storm! Don't focus on just the track itself.

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
